



Nature-based Solutions to Global Challenges Foundation Course: Pricing Policy

1. Course fees are based on whether the course participant works in the private or public/tertiary sector:
 - £3,200 private sector
 - £2,500 public/tertiary sector
2. There are approximately 10 places on the course available for those working in the public sector, based in lower-income nations and if the participant's organisation finds it difficult to meet the full fees stated above.
3. There are two fully funded scholarships available, which are funded in collaboration between the Smith School of Enterprise and the Environment and the Nature-based Solutions Initiative. Those making applications for a scholarship are likely expected to be:
 - Working in the public sector
 - Based in lower-income DAC-listed countries
4. By request, group prices may be available if an organisation purchases two or more places to an amount of approximately 5% off the full fee.
5. Places on the course are competitive, however in the occurrence that two weeks prior to the course start date places remain available, last-minute reductions to fill the course may be offered (with the exception of places obtained via the waiting list).
6. Enrolments on the course are capped at approximately 40 participants per run. Once the maximum number of enrolments has been reached a waiting list will be created.
7. A discount of up to 10% is available for participants who have successfully completed another Smith School Executive Education course. Please contact us in this regard.
8. Your place on the course will be secured when payment has been received. However, in the event of cancellation the following fees will be applied:
 - Up to six weeks prior to a course start date, full fees will be refunded minus an additional administration fee of £100 per participant
 - Up to one week prior to a course start date, 80% of the full fee will be refunded minus an additional administration fee of £100 per participant
 - Up to 24 hours prior to a course start date the full fee will be forfeited.
